

Position: Registered Nurse Educator & Integration Specialist



POSITION SUMMARY

Under the supervision of the B2W Administrative Supervisor/Integrated Care Coordinator, the B2W Registered Nurse Educator & Integration Specialist will provide patient education and health promotion activities to B2W clients while supporting care coordination and integration.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Participate in initial and ongoing training on the Evidence Based Practices (EBPs) utilized for patient service delivery. Maintains fidelity to the EBPs being utilized.
2. Conduct baseline and quarterly nursing assessments of enrolled clients.
3. Provide patient education and health promotion activities, including, but not limited to tobacco cessation, chronic disease management, and healthy lifestyles for B2W recipients.
4. Collaborates and coordinates with appropriate health professionals, the treatment team, and the client in providing correct information for clients with questions or concerns related to their diagnoses and treatment, the medications they are taking, and participation in treatment planning, particularly for medically-complex and medically-fragile B2W clients.
5. Provide patient care using traditional nursing interventions as required.
6. Participate actively in integrated care team and its' regular meetings.
7. Provide training and support to B2W staff as needed and other clinic staff as requested to support integration.
8. Consult with colleagues and be available for consultation with colleagues, students and other providers within HMS.
9. Participate in HMS quality assurance and improvement activities including chart review process and coordinating patient care closely with other medical and mental health providers within the HMS system.
10. Understand and maintain HIPAA and 42CFR Part 2 confidentiality standards relative to Hidalgo Medical Services.
11. Exhibits professional and caring manner with clients, patients and families.
12. Assume responsibility for maintaining competence in clinical practice.
13. Maintain licensure at the highest level applicable. Any change in licensure status must be communicated to HMS immediately.
14. Regularly attend continuing education activities consistent with clinical responsibilities, personal interest and in coordination with the B2W program and the Mental Health Department.
15. Participate in appropriate HMS and community-wide committee and collaboration work, as assigned by the B2W Administrative Supervisor/Integrated Care Coordinator or HMS Director of Care Coordination.
16. Perform and/or coordinate other special assignments and tasks, as required by the B2W Administrative Supervisor/Integrated Care Coordinator or HMS Director of Care Coordination.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- License to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of New Mexico
- BLS or equivalent certification or must obtain BLS or equivalent certification within 90 days of employment
- Evidence of continuing education necessary to maintain licensure

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 3-5 years relevant experience
- Individual and group teaching experience
